Commissioned through the Texas State Representatives, House Bill 18 and Senate Bill 11 from the 86th Texas Legislature provided for the implementation of best practice-based programs and research-based practices regarding mental health promotion and intervention, substance abuse prevention and intervention, suicide prevention and intervention, school safety and security infrastructure, armed defenders initiatives, and required the implementation of multi-hazard emergency operations plans as well as developed whole-community readiness programs for and in public schools.
